## Enhanced Security. Safer Transactions.

Introducing  
SC Telco Debit Cards  
& Credit Cards  
with Chip Technology.



### What is the chip?

Your Card comes equipped with a microchip--a small metal square on the front of your Card, which adds an additional level of security to your transactions at chip enabled terminals.

### Why is it important?

Chip & signature technology encrypts your transaction data, which makes it more difficult for unauthorized users to copy or access your Card information.

### How do I use it?

Insert your Card into the slot on the bottom-front of the chip enabled terminal. Leave your card inserted in the terminal until the transaction is complete. If you are using a terminal that does not have a chip card reader, simply swipe your card to make payments.

### Please Remember:

- Your Card will have a new number and PIN and must be activated within 15 days
- Your old Card will be closed once your new Card is activated
- Remember to update automatic drafts with your new Card number
- Verify we have the correct address and contact information
